VISA INFORMATION

Obligations, visa and the health insurance: Follow please all the points of Obligations including those on the visa and the health insurance. For further information concerning visa necessary for your scholarship stay in the Czech Republic, contact please the Czech Embassy in your country. RESIDENCE

The information to the Czech police for foreigners is sent by the hostel where you have the accommodation.

GRANT PAYMENT

FIRST STEPS

Your first steps should lead to your CEEPUS coordinator/partner of your host institution: please, contact this contact person two weeks before your departure at the latest - otherwise we cannot ensure your accommodation. The contact person will give you the information how to get the grant, too.

HEALTH INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE

Concerning the free medical insurance in the Czech Republic:

a. The citizens of the EU member states with a European health insurance card have a claim on free health care. They can receive the medical care card from NCO-CZ on request.

b. The citizens of EU non-member states are requested to collect a medical care card and a letter informing a doctor here in the Czech Republic - staying in Prague, in the National CEEPUS Office, and staying in other towns, at the host institution, from the contact person.

BENEFITS ENJOYED BY VISITING STUDENTS AND HOW TO APPLY FOR THEM

Benefits enjoyed by visiting students and how to apply for them: in the International Relation Office of the host faculty you will receive usually the student card and other related documents.
