VISA INFORMATION

EU member states only need valid personal ID. Other countries please check (Romania also) <http://www.mfa.gov.yu/Visas/VisasR.htm>

Information for foreign nationals visiting Serbia who are required to obtain visas:

1. Valid Passport; Letter of invitation (verified by the competent Serbian authority) or an invitation by a company for a business visit or a receipt or authorized tourist company certifying that the travel arrangement has been paid for (letter of credit or other payment receipt);
Return ticket;
Proof of sufficient funds in hard currency and
2. Certificate that a health fund shall cover the medical costs in Serbia, if any.
3. Obligations, visa and the health insurance: Follow please all the points of Obligations including those on the visa and the health insurance. For further information concerning visa necessary for your scholarship stay in the Serbia, contact please the Serbian Embassy in your country. If your arrival to Serbia is postponed due to late start of procedure the NCO can not guarantee the implementation of the mobility.

RESIDENCE

Students will be reported to the police by the University service assistance after their arrival.

Accommodation for students is provided upon reservation by the NCO. Please do check the documentation you receive carefully, you will find all necessary information in it. Accommodation for teachers is provided as well by the NCO or host institution. Please do check your documentation for further details how your accommodation is organised.

Accommodation is booked for the dates stated in your Letter of Award and the CEEPUS grant Contract. If there are changes, you have to notify the NCO by e-mail IN ADVANCE at least 30 days. Otherwise we can not guarantee the accommodation.

GRANT PAYMENT

The grant is transferred in the first week after your arrival to your host institution and you get the grant at the host institution upon presentation of your signed contract. The grant is to help you pay living cost, the accommodation is paid directly by CEEPUS NCO.
